



Toddler (24 – 36 months) This unique program introduces our youngest students to Montessori education. Toilet learning, along with socialization, independence and exploration are part of the curriculum. The toddler program consists of 3, 4, or 5 day a week options.

Children’s House (30 months – 5 years) This 5 day a week program offers the complete Montessori curriculum for daily learning in our beautifully enriched classrooms. Students entering the Children’s House program must be toileting independently.

Extended Day (4 years – 6 years – includes Kindergarten year) This afternoon program is an extension of our Children’s House morning class session. After lunch and recess, students can work on higher level curriculum. In addition, they also have special activities designed for older children including art, drama, and yoga.

Tuition Payments All tuition and childcare fees are paid using **TADS**, our online enrollment and tuition payment service. Options for payment include check, credit card, and EFT.

Payment Plans Families can choose 9 month, 10 month, or 12 month (12 month for Fulltime Care only)

Paid in Full Discount of \$150 is applied if paid in full by September 15th.

Sibling Discount of 20% is applied to Montessori tuition and Full Time Childcare for additional children of the same family.

Scholarships are available and are based solely on financial need. To apply, please turn in completed financial aid form with your most recent tax return.

Shares Subsidy is accepted for payment.

Snack Fee Small World provides daily snacks that contain whole fresh foods with as little processed foods served as possible. Each snack consists of a minimum of 2 food groups and including a fruit or vegetable.
